## Whips

Thanks to the Woodland Trust for 30 whips which we planted on 13<sup>th</sup> March.

We had planned to plant them as a hedge at the top of the Green Field where the trees have been removed.

Unfortunately, we discovered that this area is mainly brick a few inches down. This is where the old Brent Lodge stood, so the bricks maybe the remnants of the house or the foundations or a mixture. Whatever, it's not possible to plant anything of any size there.

Instead, we dispersed the whips in small clusters and singly through the Copse and the Orchard.
